Activities:

Monthly meeting – Shared Lunch

Venue: Raleigh Street Christian Centre, Raleigh Street, Leamington. (Behind the Leamington Shops). There is plenty of parking. Please note we are not affiliated to the Christian Centre, it is simply our meeting place

When: The first Tuesday of every Month.

Time: Arrive at 12.15pm for 12.30pm lunch.

Bring: A plate of food for a shared lunch and a small plate for your own use.

Meeting Cost: A charge of \$3.00 per person to cover the cost of the venue. This also covers a door prize, tea/coffee, printing of newsletters, speaker's gifts and in some cases speaker's fees.

After our shared lunch there is a guest speaker or some other form of entertainment. It is a time for getting together and meeting other members.

Newsletters although sent out via email will also be available in printed form at the monthly luncheon meetings. They are not posted to keep costs down.
