RECIPE

Easy Pumpkin Soup

Add a large knob of butter to a pan and saute 1 diced onion, 2 teaspoons of chopped thyme leaves, 1 clove of chopped garlic, 1 teaspoon of grated ginger, ½ teaspoon of ground cumin and 1 teaspoon of curry powder, until the onion is soft. Blend this mixture with 1-1½ kg of roasted butternut pumpkin and 1½ to 2 cups of chicken or vegetable stock until smooth and at the desired consistency. Season to taste with salt, pepper and a little fresh lemon juice. Enjoy
