Operatunity "Shake, Rattle & Roll" daytime concert - Friday, 1st March 2024

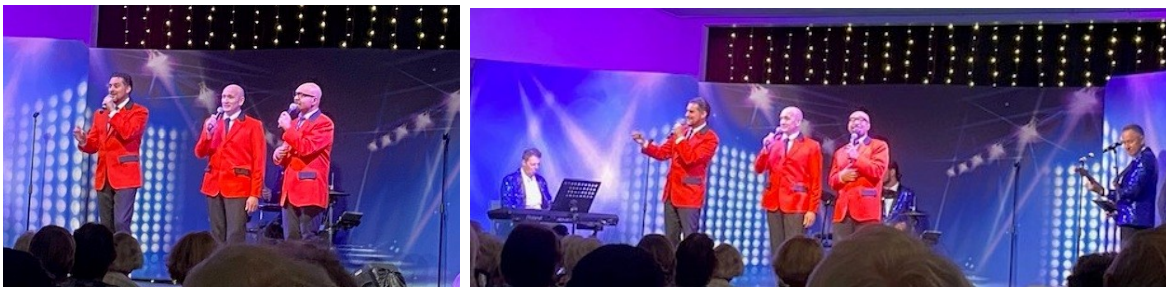
