SOUTHLAND CHEESE ROLLS

1 small onion finely diced 200 mils Evaporated Milk 1/2 packet Onion Soup Mix 250 grams Tasty Cheese grated 1 loaf sandwich Bread Butter Melted

In a pot soften the onion in a sml amount of oil Once softened add evaporated milk, onion soup mix, and grated cheese Stir until the cheese has melted then continue to mix over a low heat until the mixture thickens. Let cool til just warm On a slice of bread spread generous amount (not to thick) of the cheese mixture over Roll into a roll at this stage they can be put into the freezer. Or you can set them onto a tray which has been lined with baking paper. Brush with melted butter and bake in oven at 180 degrees for 5 to 10 mins or until golden brown Serve hot. These are ideal to keep in your freezer and to take a couple out for lunch or to have with a plate of soup in the winter.
