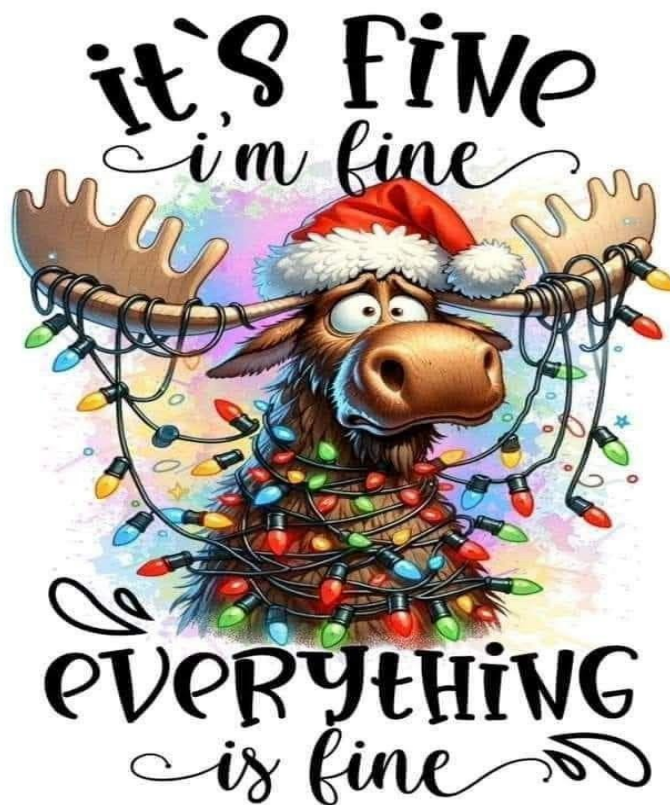
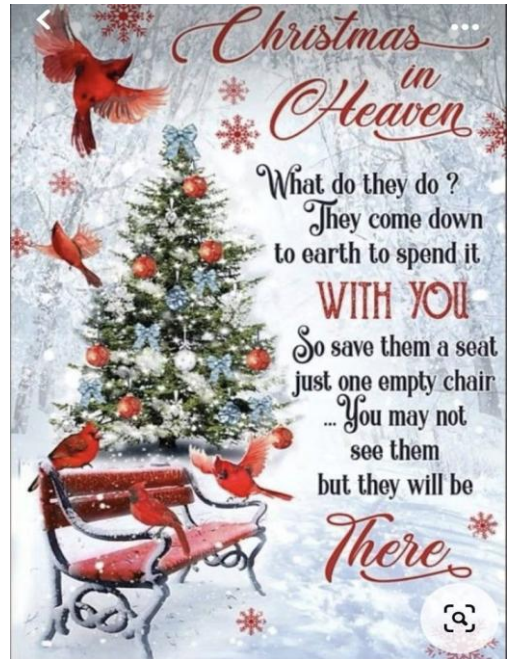
### **RAFFLES:**
